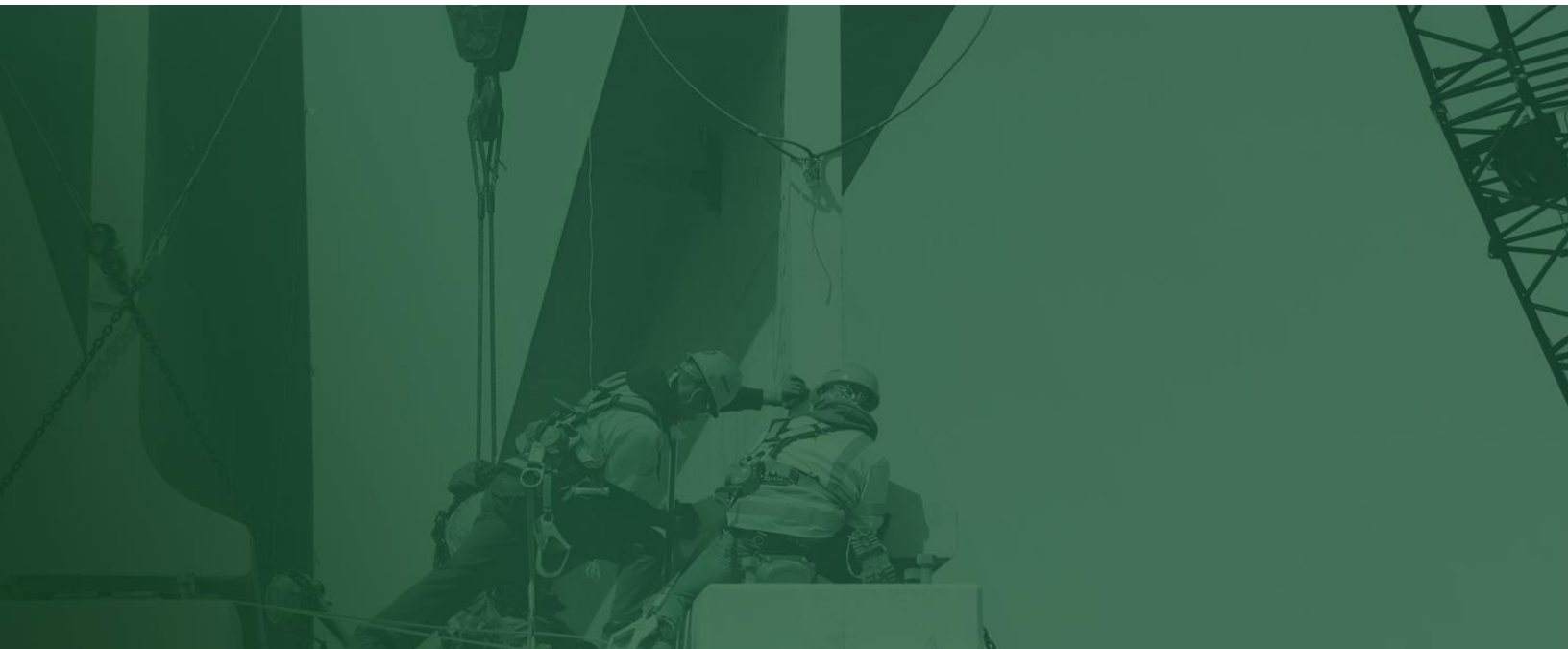

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Release 19.9 summary

This release of Compliance mobile adds supporting documents to forms and increases the space to answer questions.

NOTE:

Compliance mobile version 19.9 is backwards-compatible with web versions 19.1 and 19.7.

Improvements summary

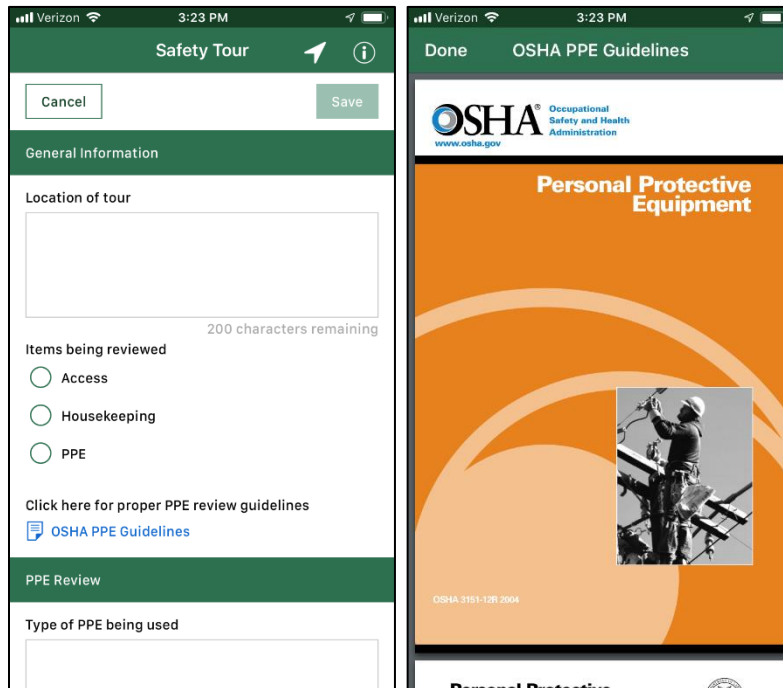
- **Supporting documents in forms** – Forms can now have supporting documents attached to them for reference. To attach a document in the web form builder, you must have Compliance web version 19.9. [Read more](#).
- **Add timestamp to mobile photos** – Add a text timestamp to a photo taken on your phone to show users when the photo was taken. [Read more](#).
- **Short Text answer character limit** – The answer character limit for the Short Text question type will increase from 150 to 200 to let you provide more information when answering.
- **Choice and List options character limit** – The options character limit for the Choice and List question types will increase from 150 to 200 to give you more space for information in the answer.

Supporting documents in forms

When you open a supporting document inside a form on mobile, it opens inside the app. When you open a document on the web, the file is downloaded.

NOTE:

To attach a document in the web form builder, you must have Compliance web version 19.9.

Add timestamp to mobile photos

When taking a photo, you can now use the  plus icon in the mobile app to add a text timestamp to your photo. You can move the timestamp anywhere on the photo and use the  text icon to edit the timestamp's font, size and alignment.
