2023.4 Release Notes

- **CBS**
 - When you left-click your computer mouse in a field, the field values now remain and do not reset to zero. Previously, when you would left-click in a field, the value in the field changed to zero intermittently.
 - When calculating the subject cost of a dependent cost item, if the owner's quantity is used to calculate the cost, the allocation distributions pay quantity is now used to calculate the subject cost. Previously, the allocation sources' pay quantity was used for the calculations.
 - When a dependent cost item created above an allocation source cost item is deleted in the CBS, the corresponding dependent cost item row in the PBS is now also deleted. Previously, the corresponding dependent cost item row in the PBS would not be deleted, and you had to delete it manually.
 - When you import a cost item assembly with sub-assemblies from the library to a job and set the option *Display after Input* for the sub-assemblies, the *Display after Input* setting is now retained.
 - Cost items now import into the library successfully when you use the Excel import option. Previously, an error message would show intermittently.
- **Pay Item & Proposal**
 - When you update the rounding precision for pay items, the total balanced price in the Pay Item & Proposal register now updates consistently.
 - When you switch between different pay item and proposal alternates, the unit and total prices for all the pay items in all alternate scenarios are now recalculated. Previously, the unit and total prices of pay items in certain alternate scenarios were set to zero.
 - Performance has improved when working with pay items with pricing option *Keep Markup with Assigned Costs* selected in estimates that have a large number of pay items.
 - You can now import pay items using the Microsoft Excel EOS format successfully. Previously, a low-level system error occurred.
- **Resource Utilization Register**
 - The selected row's totals are now shown in the grid's footer, so you can quickly see the selected totals. Previously, the footer was not showing.

- **Quotes**

- The context menu commands in the Quote Comparison & Award registers now execute successfully when multiple users are working.
- A hover over message on the delta icon now shows to communicate that the contact used on a quote has a different currency than the default quote currency.
- Performance improvements have been made when using Quote Comparison & Award.
- Scope items are no longer duplicated when you copy quotes from one job to another.

- **Report**

- When you run a preview of CBS Details report and apply a filter, the preview tab now closes when a new filter is applied, so you can run the report preview with the new filter. Previously, the preview did not update after the filter was changed.

- **User interface**

- When you open a record from a tab in a register and then close the record, the previous tab now remains. Previously, you were taken to another register tab when closing the record.
- The rows in a grid no longer shift when you use the right-click context menu while other users working in the same register add line items.
- When you use the Column Chooser and the Default Caption for a column is greater than the Custom Caption, the full Default Caption now shows. Previously, the Default Caption was truncated.
- You can now copy and paste formatted values in registers. Previously, an error showed when copying and pasting formatted values.
- The Attention dialog box that shows when you update the quantity for a cost item now shows the correct navigation path.

- **Other**

- Performance has been improved when using Alternate scenarios.
