- **Excel Workbook/Built-in spreadsheet:**
 - When a job included suspended items that were linked to a workbook and the Update Current Job folder From Workbook action was performed, the Workbook showed multiple attention dialog boxes and could possibly cause the Estimate application to crash. Now, only one attention dialog box appears when attempting to Update Current Job folder From Workbook, and Estimate does not crash.
 - When performing the Link this field to Excel action using the right-click context menu, an error occurred if there were cell names that referenced a worksheet location that is no longer valid. Now the link to Excel operations functions properly when cell references are invalid.
- **Cost Items:**
 - Subordinate cost item quantities with no resource employments would change when the parent cost item quantity changed, even if the user chose the option to **Keep all quantities of subordinates as they are**. Now, subordinate quantities remain as they were prior to changing the quantity of the parent cost item based on the selected user option.
- **Quote Management:**
 - When awarding a partial quote on a quote that included percentage-based scope item costs, such as awarding some quote items but not all quote items, the total awarded cost calculated incorrectly. Now, the percent-based scope item's costs are calculated correctly, resulting in the correct Total Awarded Quote amount.
- **Other:**
 - The automatic save function did not work when launching Estimate from the Remote Client. Code has been changed to let you enable the automatic save function when launching from Remote Client.
