Estimate on-premise

- **Quote Management**
 - When you create a quote with package prices that was copied from an existing quote, the awarded total of the original source quote could display incorrectly on the Quote Compare and Award page, even when the cost of the quote correctly contributes to the cost of the job. This could cause a user to make an incorrect award. This display issue has been fixed so the awarded total for the source quote in Quote Compare and Award now shows correctly.
- **Bid Pricing**
 - When an Estimate user attempts to use auto-price on pay items with negative balanced bid prices, such as pricing a deductive alternate, the auto-pricing routine incorrectly calculates the current prices for the negative price pay items. This resulted in an overall bid price that hit the target total, but the individual bid prices could have larger than expected variances from the balanced bid price. Now, when you auto-price a job with pay items that have negative balanced bid prices, the negative current prices are calculated proportionally based on the pay items balanced current price.
- **Microsoft Excel**
 - When multiple users are working on an estimate and using the MS Excel embedded workbook, it's possible for the workbook to become corrupt after a second user accesses and saves the workbook. This results in a COM exception error which makes the workbook inaccessible for further use until it's repaired. It's possible for the workbook to become corrupted at a point where it's no longer repairable. This issue has now been fixed.
