Release 19.7 summary

This release of Progress includes a new Timesheet summary and improvements that aid performance, consistency and data validation.

New features summary

Daily Plan

New Timesheet summary (mobile only) – You can now see allowances
allocated to employees in one view, instead of selecting individual employees to
see if they have an allowance on their timesheet. Read more.

Improvements summary

Daily Plan

- Improved mobile sync performance (mobile only) The time that it takes for mobile syncing has been greatly reduced.
- Notify when Approver or Executor are missing (mobile only) The system now
 checks whether the Approver and Executor names are present on a daily plan. If
 either have been removed from the project and are no longer present on the
 daily plan, you are notified that you need to add the missing name.
- Update Daily Plan handling of as-built codes from Control If you set Allow as-built in Control to Quantities, components are allowed against that WBS in Daily Plan, and installed quantities are received in Control. Previously, if you wanted components to be allowed against the WBS in Daily Plan and for Control to receive installed quantities, you had to set Allow as-built to All.

• Weekly Timesheet

 Don't copy expired allowance to current week - When you copy a timesheet from a previous week, the system now validates whether the allowance is still valid for the current period. If the allowance is not valid, it is not copied, but all other associated records are copied.

• Time Center

- Consistent Task ID fields The format of Task ID fields was made consistent across the product. <u>Read more</u>.
- Send to Payroll change Time Center now only sends the most current timecard version and does not consider previous versions, which helps optimize system performance. There is no change to sending emergency timecards. Any version can be sent.
- Toggle premium field based on reason code When adding or changing the reason code in the Employee or Equipment grid in Time Center, the system



enables or disables the premium field based on the reason code's project setting.




Daily Plan


New Timesheet summary (mobile only)

The new Timesheet summary page lets you see the allowances allocated to employees in one place. Previously, you had to select individual employees to see if the employee had an allowance assigned to their timesheet.

Consistent Task ID fields

The Task ID fields were changed so that all the controls work the same across the product. The new format is:

Segment 1 + "." + Segment 2 + "." Segment 3 + "." Segment 4 + " - " + Description

Changes were made to the Add/Copy Labor, Allowance, Equipment and Maintenance Timecards slideouts as well as the Query builder and Bulk edit slide-outs.
